Brian and Megan have been stepping up to help with the pool,

Issue addressed about Megan Raifsnyder and a pool patron. Joe will talk with both parties.

Joe felt the staffing at the pool was "good", and Lawrana stated the swim team was "good" as well.

Caden Moyer, increase of pay. Jess discussed with members about struggling with orders, but willing to learn and take advice. He is performing duties of concession schedule. Will address his raise at the next meeting.

Kimbrele has not been stepping up this year, but Thea has been responsible. Steph made a motion to make her a Lead in the concession stand at \$10.00. Carl second. Motion passed. 5-0.

Jack has improved since last year. Teaching life skills.

Discussed increasing staff on Day Care days. Making sure the hot foods are being made. The senior lead will check to make sure food is being made. The Concession stand will "front load staff" per Lawrana. Also check inventory after they leave.

The Daycare will start next week on Wed, then changed to Tuesday.

Joe, pool manager, brought up that Caden Moyer's title/pay should be changed since he is performing the work of an assistant manager. Following discussion, it was decided that we only have one pool manager and one assistant manager. We would change to "senior Lead". J. Martin made a motion to increase his salary to \$12.00, re-evaluate at the next meeting (30 days). S. Luckey second. Carl-abstained. Motion passed. 4-0.

Kirstin was having difficulties with the I-pads with the internet. It was discussed that they need to be refreshed in order for items to load.

Pool/Pavilion:

New upright freezer was delivered. Whirlpool called due to being too hot.

New lighting installed- cost of \$10,000. Working fine.

New shed placed. Lost original key, but Brandon has a key. No ramp needed.

Fence replaced around the shed. New Gate installed for \$3500. A pole in the fenceline needs to be removed due to being sharp.

No issues with chlorine. Baby pool pump blowing fuses. Kyle will check if electrical issues if not will purchase a new pump.

Online Memberships:

The process is working. 202 memberships to date. Swim team members: 105 members. Pavilion Rentals: Sandy/Kirstin sending the rentals to Steph Luckey. We must have a deposit to hold the rental two weeks prior to rental. There are 9 rentals to date. This is only to be changed by the Pool Manager.

Look at splitting the basketball court in half to make pickleball courts. Need to have courts lined.

LCBC utilized a playground at the beginning of the summer. A Leesport usage agreement was made. E-mailed to sandy.

Concession Stand Window broken –Borough will replace prior to community days.

Brick Project: "Bricks R Us". See attached informational letter. Will be a 6 month program. From December until March(Christmas time) and then April-May (Tax time).
