## ordinance no. 379

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEESPORT, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 365 BY RESTRICTING THE PARKING OF CERMAIN TYPES OF VEHICLES ON BOROUGH STREETS AND INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.

The Borough of Leesport ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Borough of Leesport Ordinance No. 365 is hereby amended as follows:

A. Section 4. of ARTICLE III shall read as follows:

Section 4. Parking of Certain Vehicles. It shall be unlawful for any person to park, or allow to remain parked, a commercial motor vehicle with a registered gross weight in excess of 7,000 pounds, a motor home, a camper, a recreational vehicle, a boat, camping or utility trailer or any other similar motorized or non-motorized vehicle or device on any Borough street for more than a twenty-four (24) hour period during the months of November, December, January, February and March.

Section 5. <u>Penalty for Violation</u>. Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600.00 and costs.

SECTION 2. All existing ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and affect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect December (6, 1998.
