## ordinance no. 380

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEESPORT AMENDING THE LEESPORT ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1972, AS AMENDED, BY PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR PRIVATE NON-COMMERCIAL SWIMMING POOLS.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Leesport, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 503.1 of the Leesport Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1972, as amended, is amended by the addition of the following:

Section 503.1

d. Permanent swimming pools shall be entirely enclosed with a permanent barrier or fence not less than four feet (4') in height, such fence having no opening with a dimension greater than four inches (4") a side (or in diameter in the case of round openings). Where such pools are of the type having above-ground construction, that portion of the pool wall extending above the ground may be included as part of the barrier or fence. Fences or barriers shall have a gate which shall be securely locked when not in use. Above-ground pools shall have a ladder or stairway which can be removed or rendered unusable and the entrance to the pool shall be capable of being securely closed to a height of four feet (4').

**SECTION 2.** All existing ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby expressly repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
