Grant Awarded for Emergency Generators

In March of this year, Leesport Borough was awarded a \$119,983 grant from the Local Shares Account through the Commonwealth Financing Authority. The Local Shares Account program was established by the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act of 2004, which "provides for the distribution of gaming revenues though the financing authority to support projects in the public interest".



The funds will be used to purchase and have installed two emergency generators at borough well sites as a source of standby emergency power. In the event of a lengthy and catastrophic power outage, the well pumps would not be able to operate. The generators will solve this problem.

A third emergency generator will be installed at the borough hall.



LBA Awarded Grant

The Leesport Borough Authority was awarded a \$415,000 American Rescue Plan (ARP) grant by the Berks County Commissioners for their Aeration Project. Wastewater aeration is the process where air is circulated through, mixed with or dissolved in a liquid or substance. Aeration brings water and air into contact in order to remove dissolved gases, such as carbon dioxide and hydrogen sulfide, and to oxidize dissolved metals, including iron and volatile organic compounds (VOCs).




